APPLICATION DEADLINE:

- July 1st
 - Classes begin in the fall (August).
 - Any Pre-admission courses must be completed by the end of the Summer Semester.
- November 15
 - Classes begin in the spring (January).
 - Any Pre-admission courses must be completed by the end of the A-Block Fall Semester, <u>OR</u> 16-week Fall Semester courses must be in progress (midterm grade will be used).¹

The Computed Tomography Program is a selective admission program, and a points-based system determines admission. To see how points are determined, refer to the <u>Candidate Selection Form</u>. A 2.75 GPA is required to be eligible for this program. Incomplete files will not be considered. Complete the following by the application deadline:

- Complete the Ozarks Tech Admissions process.
- Official transcripts from accredited schools attended other than Ozarks Tech must be received by Ozarks Tech Admissions before the application deadline (preferably 4-6 weeks prior, to allow time for review).
- Submit a CT (Computed Tomography) program application using the online application portal
 apply.otc.edu by the application deadline (preferably 4 weeks before the deadline).
 - Will need to upload your current proof of at least one of the following:
 - ARRT (R)
 - ARRT (N)
 - CNMT (NMTCB)
 - ARRT (T)
 - Provide the institution that provided you with your imaging degree or certificate.
 - Upload proof of an associate's degree or higher (if applicable)
 - Provide a professional resume that lists dates and includes references
- Complete TOEFL testing if English is not the student's native language and upload results during the online application process by the application deadline.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT:

Students whose first language is not English must document their English language proficiency. This requires:

- Minimum TOEFL iBT passing score of 81, with a minimum speaking score of 24. *Program will waive
 TOEFL requirement if the student has already obtained a bachelor's degree from a US regionally accredited
 University*
- Student must satisfy this requirement by submitting a current TOEFL iBT score (Test of English as a Foreign Language) during the online application process by the application deadline.
- Testing is completed through the TOEFL website.
- The TOEFL report scores are valid for 5 years from the test date.
- This is separate from the test taken to be admitted to Ozarks Tech.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE:

- Based upon the program's admission scoring system, the 20 applicants with the highest score will be
 offered a position in the program and will receive information on the necessary steps to complete the
 program admissions.
- Information regarding acceptance or non-acceptance into the program will be delivered to students via the online application portal.
- The accepted students will receive an acceptance packet task list through their Ozarks Tech email account to complete the admission process.

REAPPLICATION:

- ✓ Applicants not selected for admission can reapply online for the next deadline.
